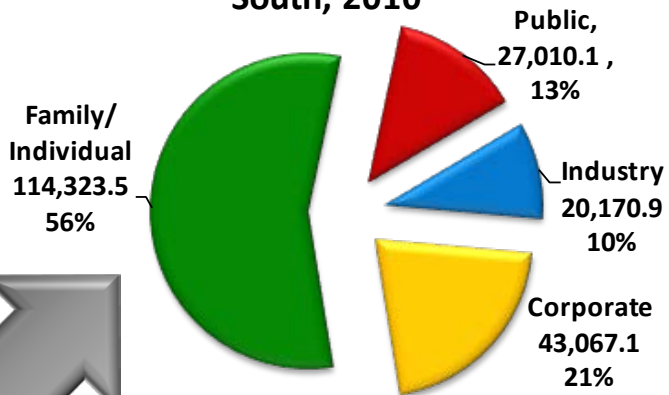
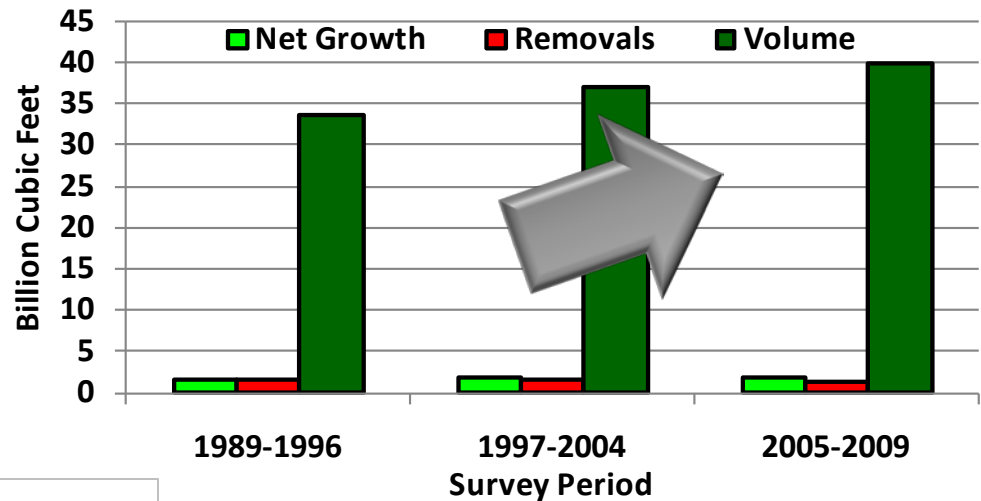

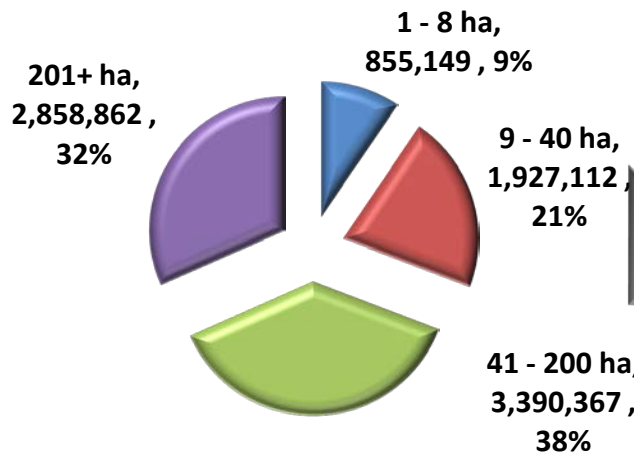
**Timberland Ownership in the South, 2010**

Volume of Live Trees by Survey Period, GA**



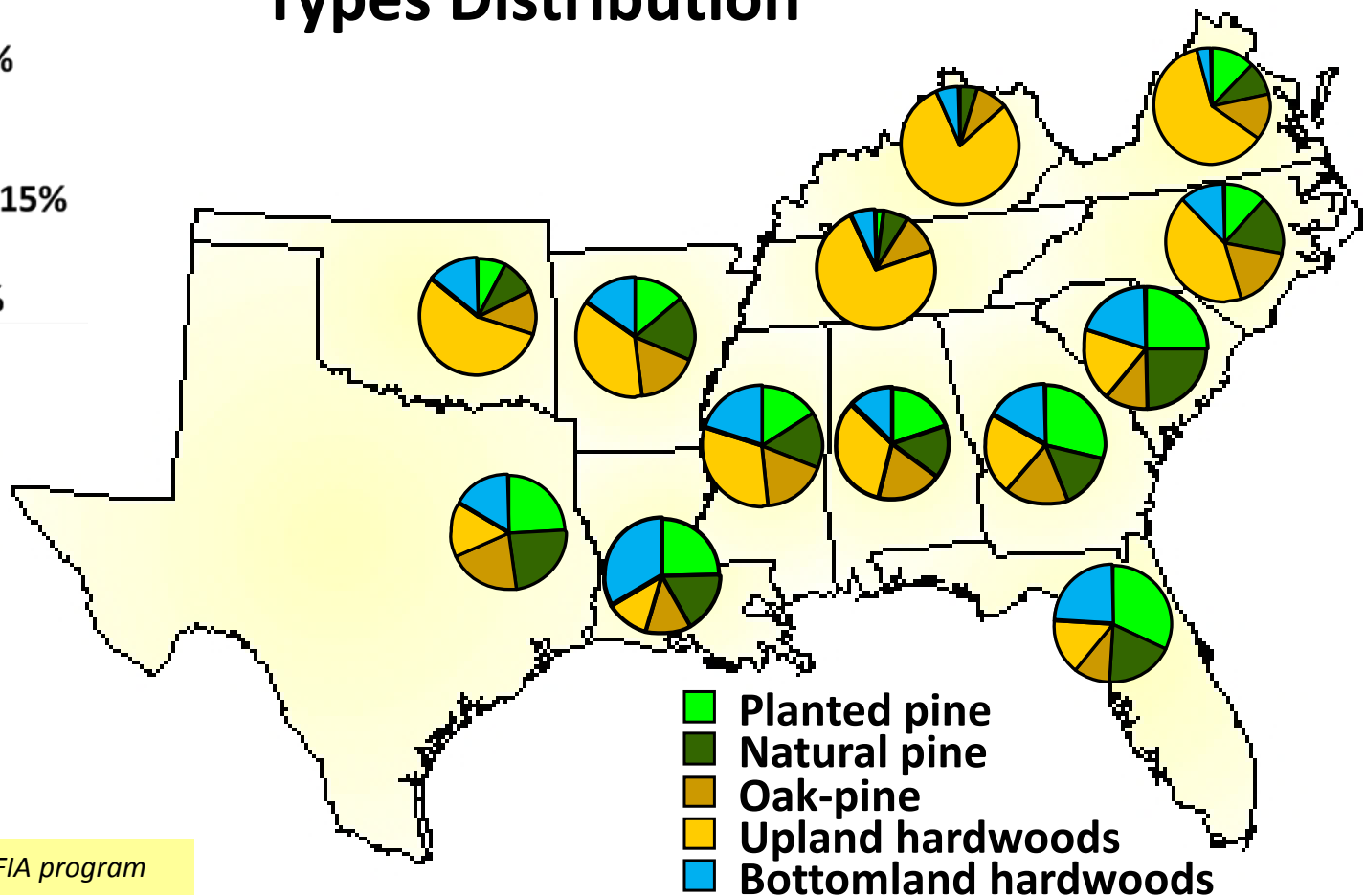
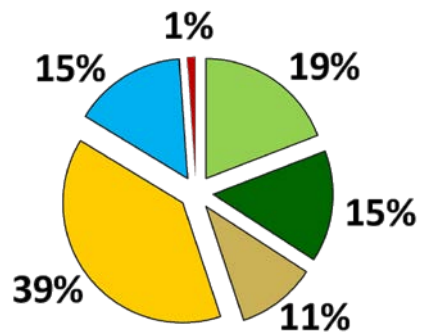
**Area of Private Ownership by Tract Size on Timberland, GA 2010**

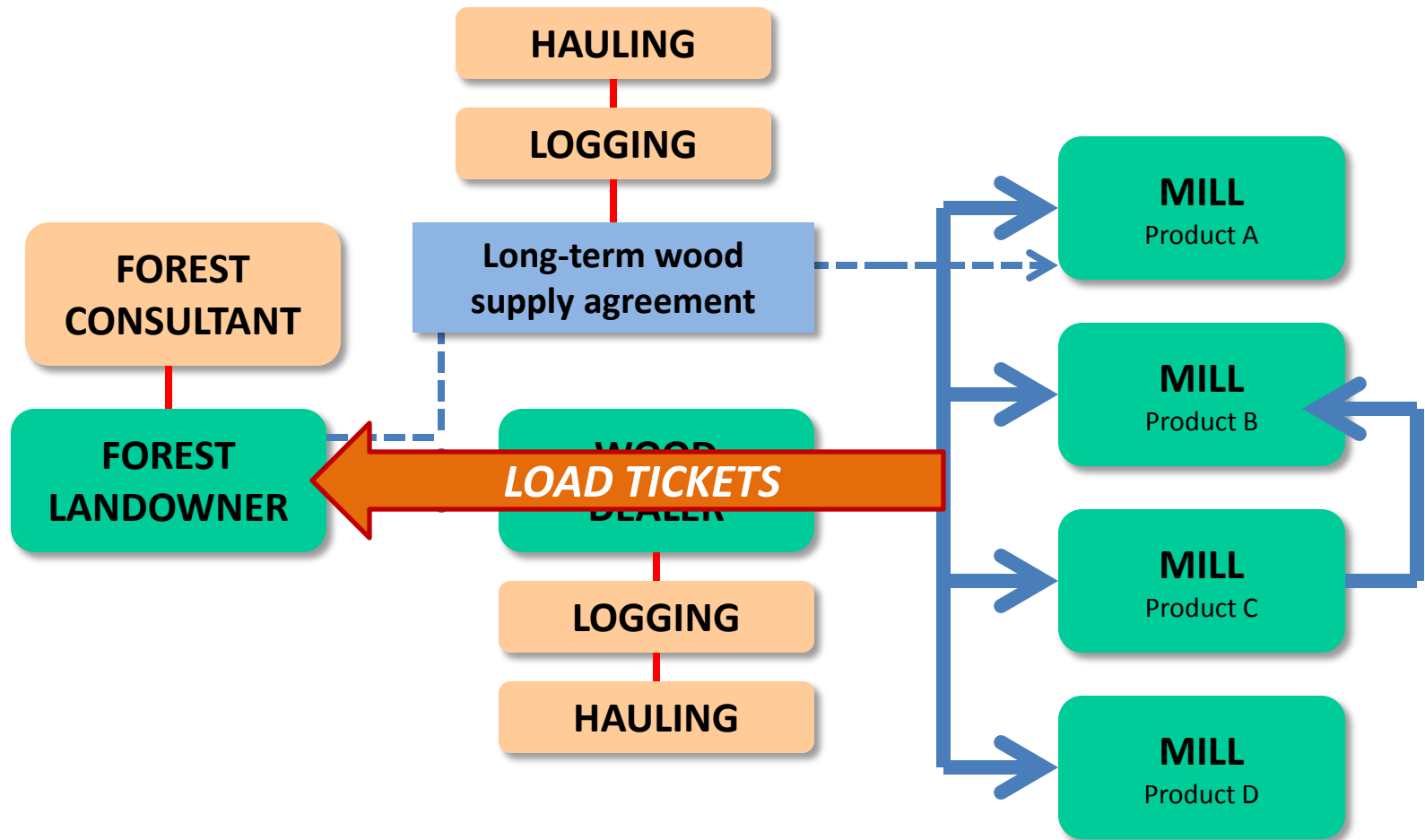

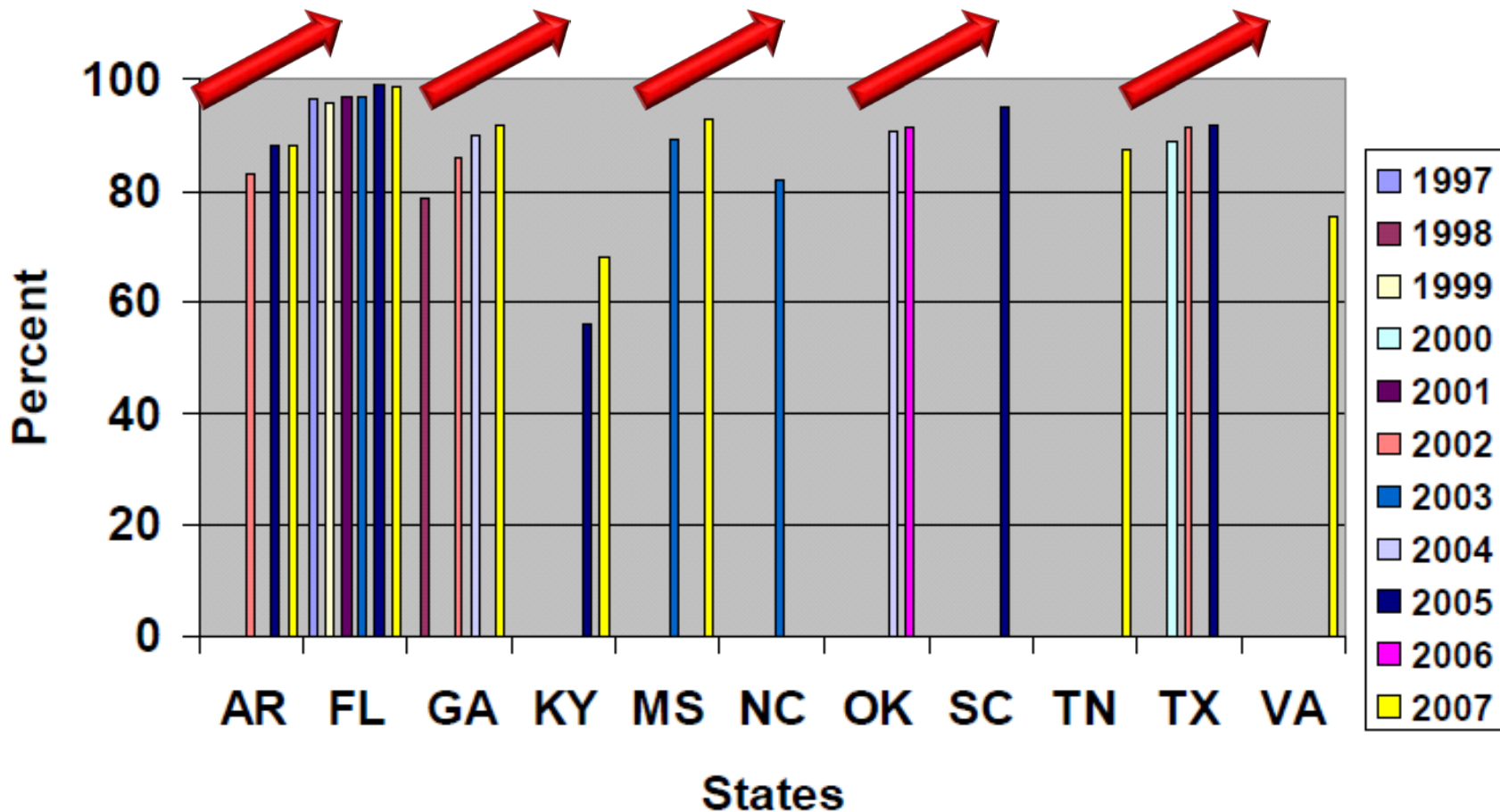

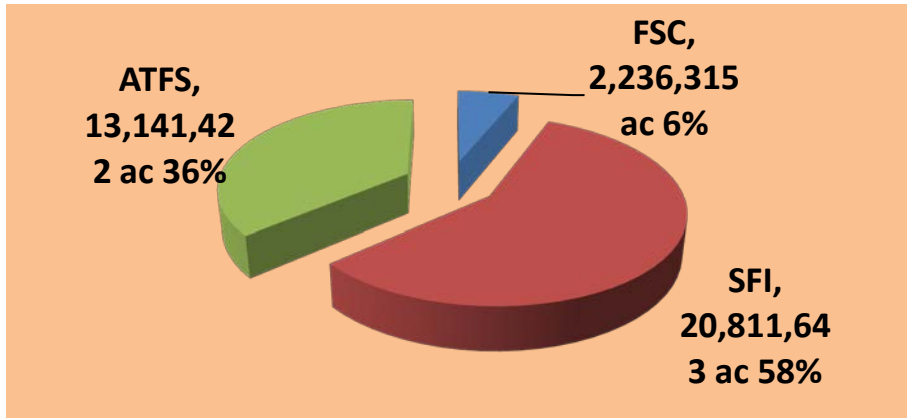

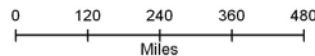
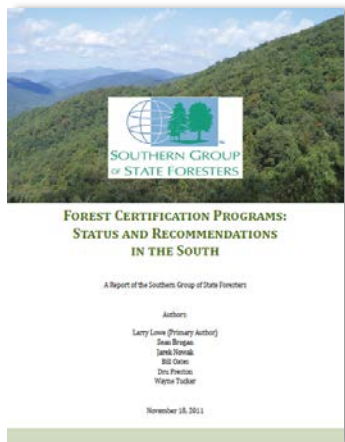
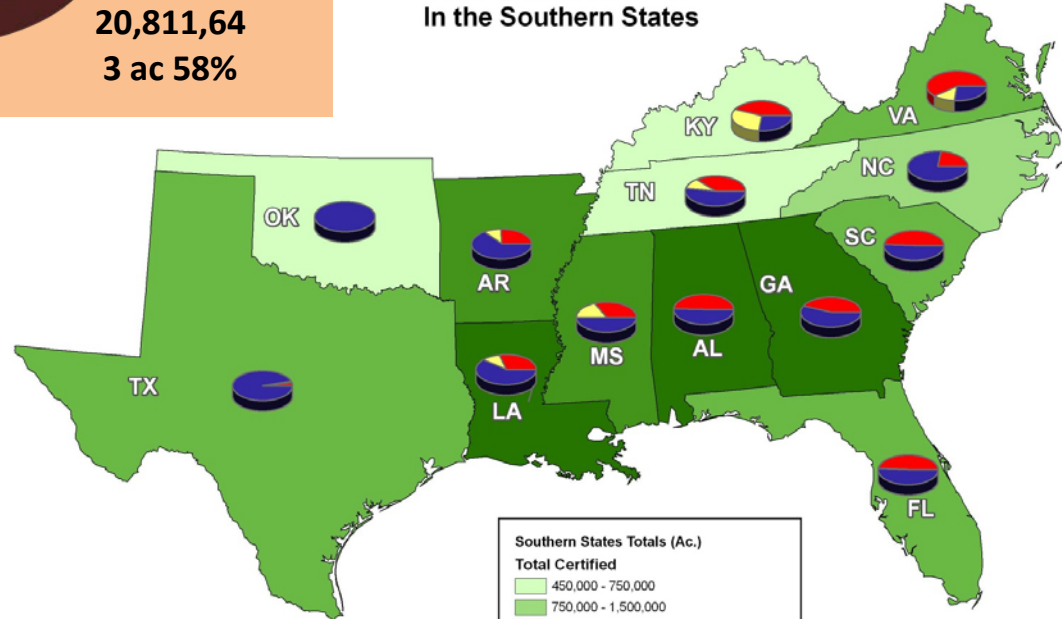
Figure 8: BMP Implementation - Overall



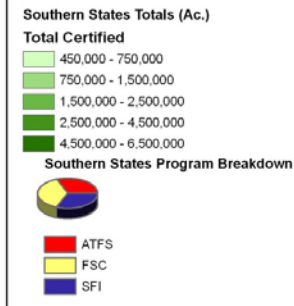

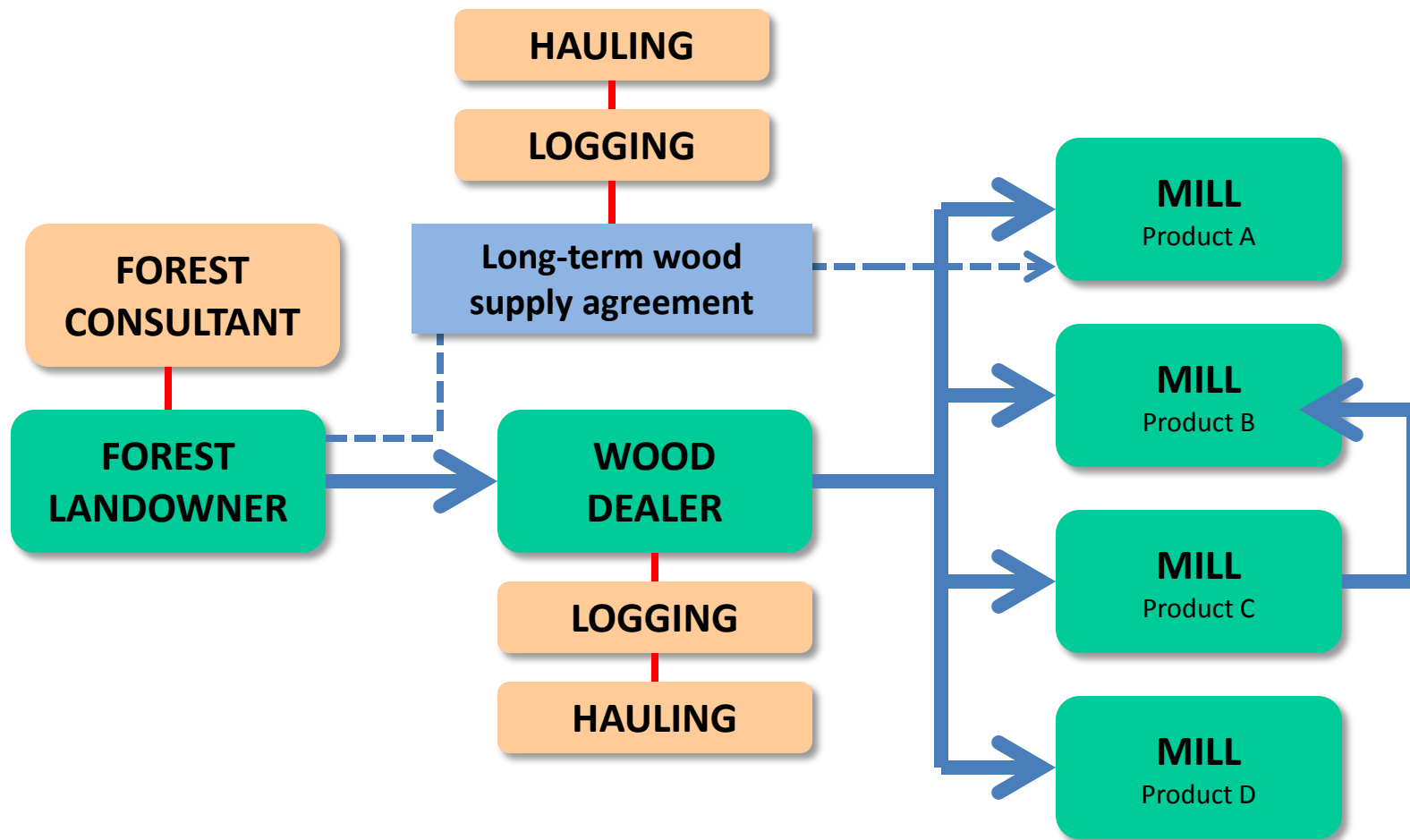
Certified Forestlands

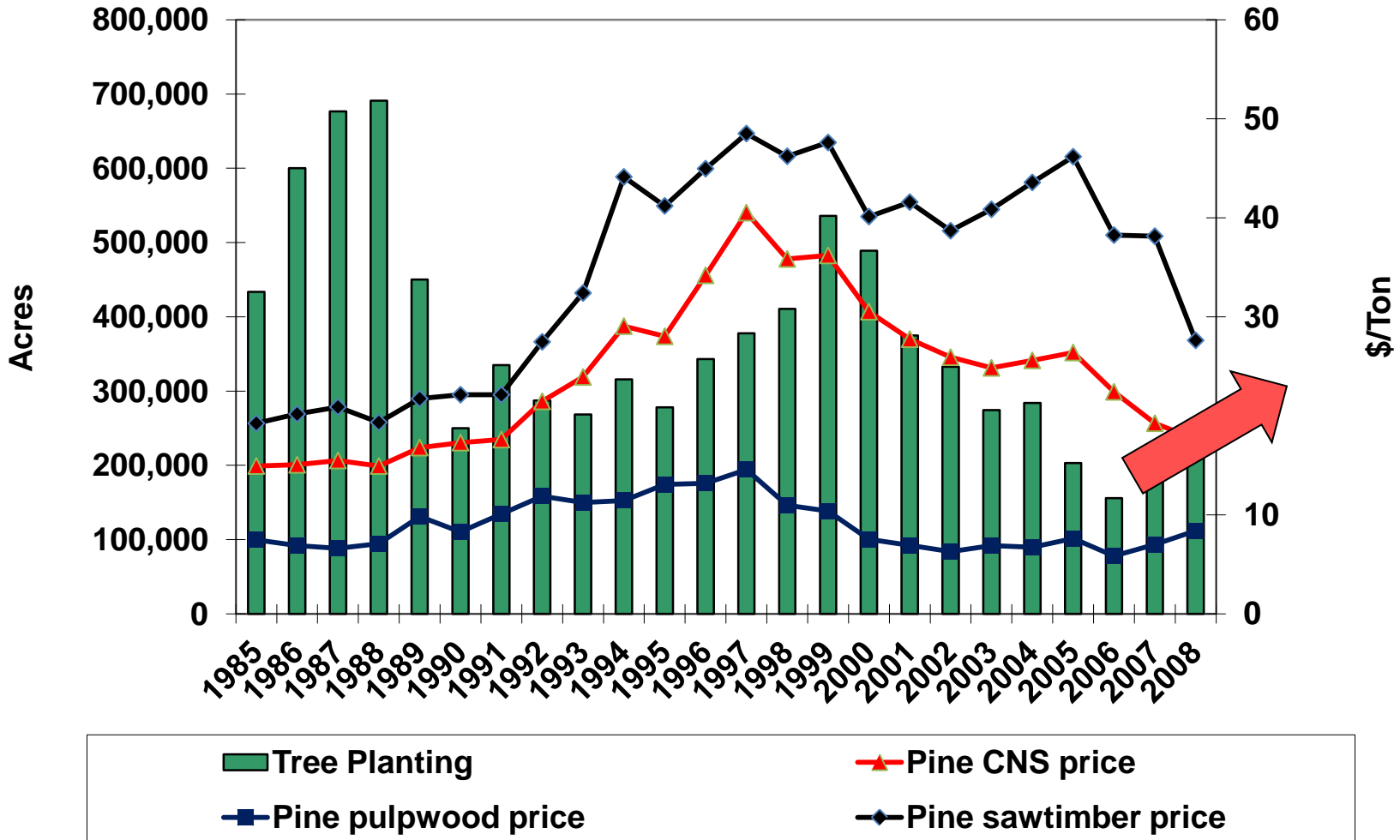
